**MOTION BY SERVER TO GO, INC. FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER AND
EXTENSION OF TIME TO PRODUCE RESPONSIVE DOCUMENTS**

Server to Go, Inc. (“STG”), by and through its counsel, moves the Court for entry of a protective order pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c) governing and limiting the use of confidential information requested by the Receiver and the Securities Exchange Commission in this matter. STG also moves the Court to extend the time period for it to produce documents responsive to the Receiver’s First Request for Production of Documents for an additional two days after entry of the proposed Protective Order. In support of this motion, STG states as follows:

1. In accordance with the Court’s April 26, 2006 Order, the Receiver and STG served document requests upon one another. The Receiver’s First Request for Production of Documents to STG was dated May 9, 2006.

2. STG previously produced more than 400 pages worth of documentation to the Receiver in response to subpoenas served on it prior to the First Request for Production.

3. The Receiver’s First Request for Production of Documents seeks the production of financial statements, tax returns and other confidential business information, as well as other
