**STIPULATED ORDER FOR RETURN OF PROPERTY OF THE RECEIVERSHIP
ESTATE TRANSFERRED TO ANGLO FAR-EAST BULLION CORPORATION**

This matter is presently before the Court upon the Motion for Entry of Stipulated Order for Return of Property of the Receivership Estate Transferred to Anglo Far-East Bullion Corporation (“Anglo Far East”) submitted by Larry E. Cook, Receiver and Anglo Far East. The Court finds as follows:

1. Larry E. Cook (the “Receiver”) was appointed as Receiver for Capital Enhancement Club, Marroc Corporation, and others by this Court on May 4, 2005.

2. The Receiver, in coordination with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”), the Commission’s Office of International Affairs, and the Latvian Prosecutor’s Office identified and froze \$80,000 of investor funds in an account held by Anglo Far-East Bullion Corporation at Krajbanka in Riga, Latvia. A total of \$160,322.37 was in the account at the time the account was frozen.

3. The Receiver and Anglo Far East have agreed that \$80,000 of the total \$160,322.37 is traceable to investor funds transferred to Anglo Far East via relief defendant Marroc Corporation. The balance of the account may be released to Anglo Far East. A Consent Directive signed by Philip Judge, Anglo Far East’s Managing Director, is attached to this Order as **Exhibit A**.

4. All parties to this action have received due notice of this proceeding as required by United States law.

5. For good cause shown, the Court finds the Receiver's Motion should be granted.

Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Anglo Far East Bullion Corporation, c/o Oskars Apse, FPMC, World Trade Centre Riga, 2 Elizabetes str. 433, Riga, LV-1330, Latvia immediately pay to the Receiver the following funds held at Latvijas Krajbanka A/S, 2 Jekaba Street, Riga, Latvia, Registration Number 40003098527 in the Commercial Register of Latvia, in account number , US\$ 80,000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Latvijas Krajbanka A/S, 2 Jekaba Street, Riga, LV-1955, Latvia, Registration Number 40003098527 in the Commercial Register of Latvia, immediately pay to the Receiver the following funds held in Anglo Far East Bullion Corporation account number, withholding reasonable bank fees, if necessary: US\$80,000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Latvijas Krajbanka A/S shall pay the funds to the Receiver's local counsel, Sorainen Law Offices, Krisjana Valdemara iela 21, Riga, Latvia, Registration No. 000335589 in the Commercial Register of Latvia, and that Sorainen Law Offices shall forward the funds to the Receiver, converting into US Dollars any amounts in currencies other than US Dollars and withholding reasonable bank fees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after transferring US\$80,000 to Sorainen Law Offices, Latvijas Krajbanka A/S may return the balance of funds in Anglo Far East Bullion Corporation account number to Anglo Far East Bullion Corporation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Latvijas Krajbanka A/S shall release to the Receiver all bank account records for Anglo Far East Bullion Corporation account number at Latvijas Krajbanka A/S.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is entered into full force and effect and is enforceable under United States law and other jurisdictions as the case may be, as of the date of this Order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

CONSENT DIRECTIVE

I, Philip Judge, do hereby make this consent directive both individually and on behalf Anglo Far-East Bullion Corp., and do hereby voluntarily direct Krajbanka, with respect to the following account:

-Anglo Far-East Bullion Corp., Account Number (the "Account") at Krajbanka, Jekaba street 2, Riga, LV-1955, Latvia

to:

A. Disclose all information and deliver copies of all documents of every nature in its possession or control which reflect or relate in any manner to a US\$80,000 wire transfer from Marroc Corporation to the Account on December 3, 2004; and

B. Pay the sum of US\$ 80,000 from the Account to Larry E. Cook, court-appointed receiver in Civil Case No. 05-4057-RDR in the United States District Court for the District of Kansas.

This consent directive shall be irrevocable authority for so doing.

Upon receipt of the US\$80,000, Larry E. Cook, court-appointed receiver, disclaims any and all interest in the Account.

This consent directive is intended to apply to the laws of the United States and all foreign jurisdictions, without limitation.
